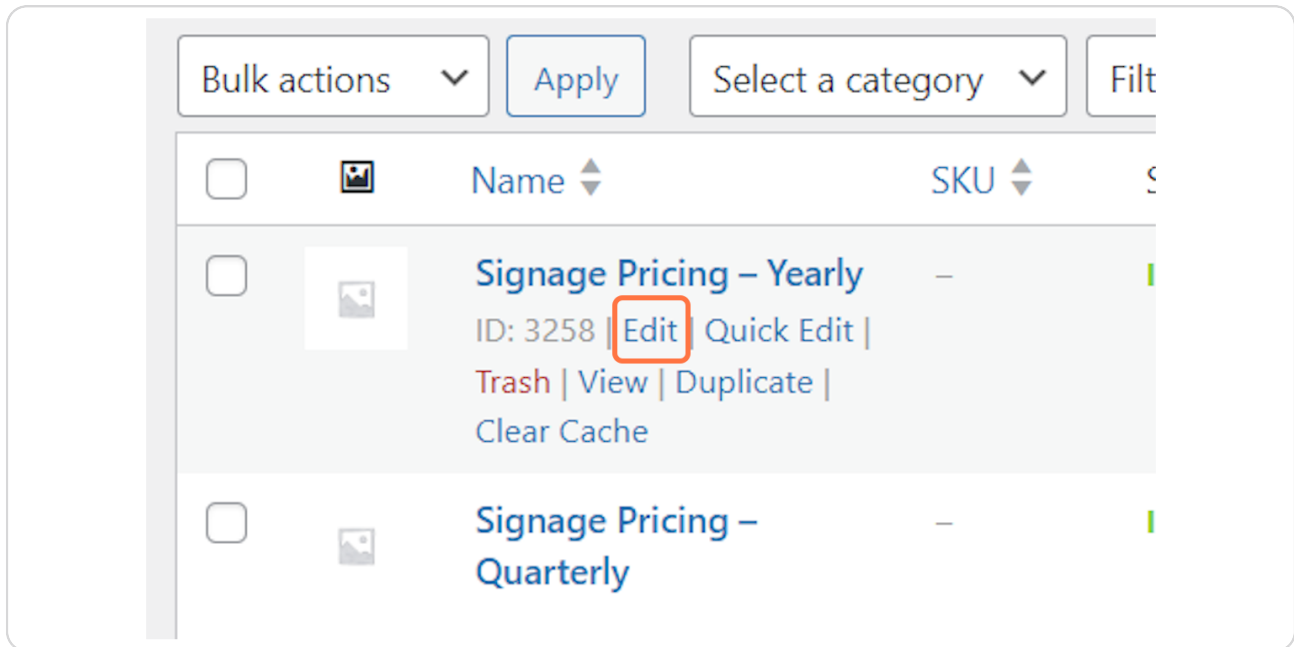



Click on Regular price (US\$) (To change For USD)





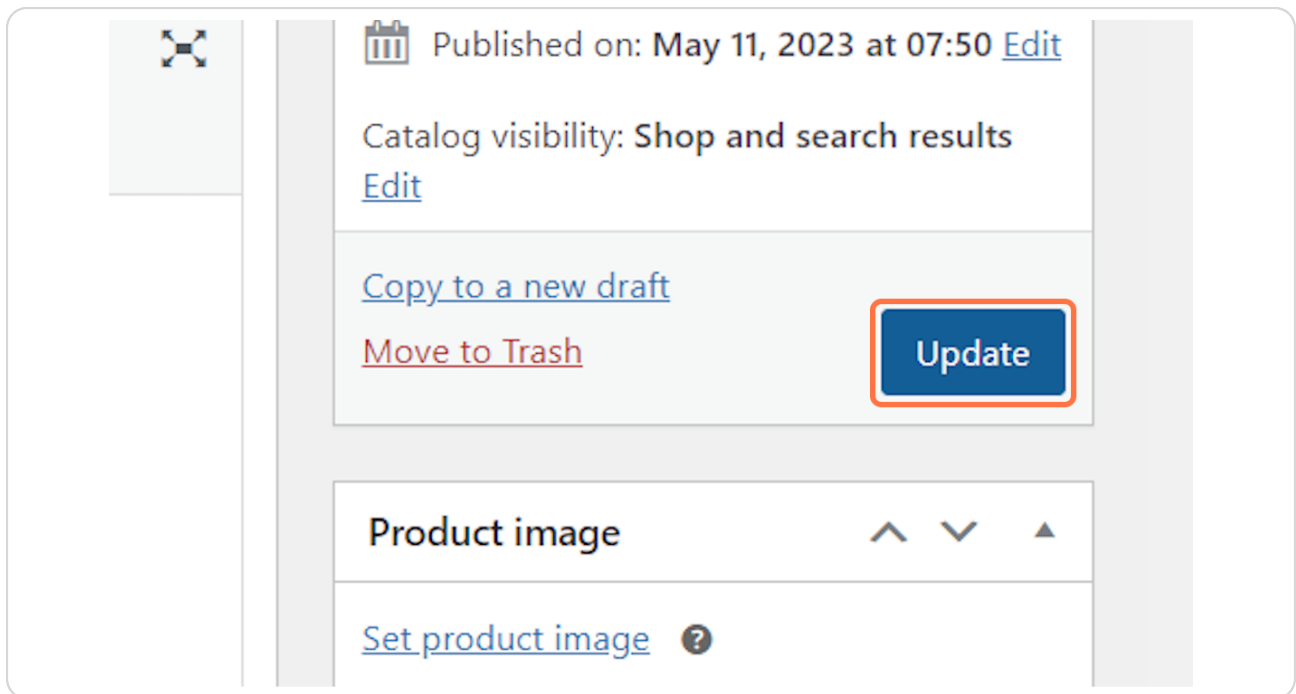
